Divine: pertaining to the one true God

Deity: the divine quality that distinguished God from all other entities; therefore God cannot be likened to any created thing

There are Three Unique, Distinct Persons of the Godhead that We Call the Trinity

The one true God has revealed Himself as the eternally self-existent, "I AM," the Creator of heaven and earth and the Redeemer of mankind. He has further revealed Himself as the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
